

We are taking a stand for 5 important Freedoms:

- Freedom of Speech.
- Freedom of Movement.
- Freedom of Choice.
- Freedom of Assembly.
- Freedom of Health.

We are advocating for 5 important Objectives:

- End Lockdowns: create and pass legislation that prohibits the use of lockdowns, as public health policy, including but not limited to individual movement distance limitations, business closures, or specification of acceptable reasons to leave home.
- End Mask Mandates: create and pass legislation to prohibit the use of mask mandates as public health policy.
- Prevent Vaccine Mandates and Coercion: create and pass legislation to prohibit the imposition of vaccine requirements, legal conditionality based on vaccination status, or the imposition of Vaccination status documentation ("Vaccine Passports") as a requirement for any activities.
- Return to Standard International and Domestic Travel: enable international and domestic flights and travel without any quarantine requirements, travel restrictions, or border closures that did not exist prior to January 2020.
- End all State of Emergency Declarations: deactivate all State of Emergency declarations that exist in response to Coronavirus and rescind all additional executive emergency powers that are being used by governments to implement the abovementioned totalitarian population control restrictions.

We are building our Movement upon 5 important Principles:

- Decentralization: The Freedom Movement is comprised of a large variety of different independent groups and activist organizations.
 - The World Wide Demonstration Team asserts that decentralization is important to increase the resilience of the movement and allow maximum choice for individual participants.
 - We aim to devolve the maximum amount of decision-making to the local city level, and co-ordinate with minimal overhead at the National and International level.
 - We aim to maximize the number of informed co-equal participants in our decision-making processes.
 - Our Movement is bottom-up, not top-down.
- Collaboration: The Freedom Movement is built of people from a wide range of perspectives and viewpoints.
 - The World Wide Demonstration Team asserts that Collaboration is important to build positive-sum relationships between different groups and build a unified support structure.
 - We aim to maximize the amount of co-operation that is possible between different groups.
 - We aim to maximize the quality and quantity of partnering groups and individuals in our events, and to support other events that align with our objectives.
 - Our Movement is pluralist, not maximalist.
- Community: The Freedom Movement is maintained and grown by ordinary people, who volunteer their time to advocate for Freedom.
 - The World Wide Demonstration Team asserts that Community is important to build relationships between Freedom supporting individuals in local areas to empower them in their resistance to authoritarianism.
 - We aim to maximize the amount of community involvement in events, and to foster one-to-one and many-to-many connectivity and friendships between the attendees of our events.

- We aim to maximize the quality and quantity of informal public and private social events that build community within the movement at the local level.
- Our Movement is social, not stagnant.
- Stability: The Freedom Movement is built on a solid foundation of consistently meeting the expectations of our event attendees and minimizing public-facing internal conflict.
 - The World Wide Demonstration Team asserts that Stability is important to enable large numbers of attendees to reliably choose to attend our events with minimal cognitive overhead.
 - We aim to resolve internal disputes between different organizers and groups privately and present a unified front to the world.
 - We aim to provide a reliability guarantee to our event attendees that our events will not be cancelled or postponed once announced publicly, regardless of legal or social pressures.
 - Our Movement is consistent, not confusing.
- Peace: The Freedom Movement is non-violent and does not instigate, advocate for, or initiate physical conflict. We hold that the Human Rights to life, liberty and security of person and property are paramount.
 - The World Wide Demonstration Team asserts that Peace is important to enable regular people to participate in our events and achieve widespread acceptance among the population.
 - We aim to minimize the number and severity of violent incidents that occur during our events and minimize the amount of advocacy for violence that is expressed by our event attendees.
 - We aim to minimize the amount of physical disruption that results to bystanders of our events and minimize the damage to property that occurs during our events.
 - Our Movement is peaceful, not violent.

We are advocating for 5 Solutions:

- Non-Compliance: We Will Not Comply with tyranny and use our noncompliance to inspire others to join us.
 - We ask the individuals in the Freedom Movement to not comply with any authoritarian restrictions to the maximum possible extent.
 - We ask that you help others to begin their journey of noncompliance by being a positive example of what Freedom looks like.
 - We ask that you push back against enforcement measures with legal pressure, social pressure, economic pressure, and political pressure.
- Empowerment: We Will become more powerful and use that power to support Freedom.
 - We ask individuals in the Freedom Movement to start or join new political institutions based on our principles, win elected public office, and implement our objectives.
 - We ask that you start new businesses that support our principles by enabling equal access to trade with all customers, regardless of government edicts to the contrary, and advertise your stances with your customers widely, and that you support existing businesses that publicly support our objectives with your financial decisions by purchasing their products, services, and publicly traded shares.
 - We ask that you discover how you can shift the value of your economic activity to decentralized currencies and exit the fractional reserve central banking and fiat currency systems, upon which your government depends to extract value and finance its control measures.
- Freedom Preserving Institutions: We will build bases of legitimacy and use that legitimacy to support Freedom.
 - We ask the individuals in the Freedom Movement to build new institutions that can generate consensus over human actions at scale, and to implement advocacy for our principles and objectives within the scope of that consensus.

- We ask that you create or join Freedom Movement event organizing groups in your city, and support them with your time, energy, input, and professional skills.
- We ask that you support the output consensus of Freedom Preserving Institutions by participating in their governance processes, inviting new people to participate, and supporting them with your financial decisions by contributing funding, networked relationships, and resources.
- Freedom Culture: We will become more influential and use that influence to support Freedom.
 - We ask the individuals in the Freedom Movement to start new media producing institutions that support our objectives, and create videos, music, art, movies, news, and other creative content that can reach a large audience, and advocate for our principles and objectives within that cultural output.
 - We ask you to support creators that advocate for the principles of Freedom with your viewership, financial support, and share their work with others.
 - We ask that you publicly and rigorously refute the promotion of tyrannical restrictions to Human Freedom with counterarguments in-band with whatever medium it appears within.
- Shift The Narrative: We will become more persuasive and use that persuasion to support Freedom.
 - We ask the individuals in the Freedom Movement to create and promote new language conventions that encapsulate the premises of our arguments within them.
 - We ask you push back against the premises and language manipulations that are pushed in the public sphere by rejecting the premises and language conventions of pro-tyranny arguments.
 - We ask that you create communication platforms, join existing platforms, and invite new users to join you on platforms that support Freedom of Speech and enable the free flow of ideas, the circumstances under which our arguments thrive.
